# Frequently Asked Questions

## BioMarin Patient and Physician Support (BPPS)

Beginning a unique treatment such as NAGLAZYME™ (galsulfase) can seem challenging at first. That's why BPPS is here to help. We'll help you through the process, step by step.

Through BPPS, BioMarin is committed to working with you, your family, your healthcare providers (physicians, nurses, and staff), and insurance companies to help make your treatment with NAGLAZYME as easy as possible.

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### **Will my insurance cover my NAGLAZYME therapy?**

Because NAGLAZYME treats a rare medical condition, health insurance policies and treatment center arrangements may not automatically be in place. BPPS will work with you, your physician's office, your health insurance company, and your infusion center to assist you in insurance and coordination issues.

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## How can BPPS help?

The staff at BPPS is trained to assist you in securing insurance coverage, identifying treatment centers, setting up appointments, and answering reimbursement questions you have along the way.

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## How do I sign up for the BPPS program?

To sign up, call BPPS toll free at 1-866-906-6100, option #1, to request an enrollment kit. Complete the patient authorization form included in the enrollment kit, and return the signed form in the pre-paid envelope. Once BPPS receives your signed authorization, a case manager can begin working on your reimbursement paperwork.

BioMarin works with several programs to help under-insured patients or patients between insurance policies gain insurance coverage for NAGLAZYME™ (galsulfase) therapy. Please call BPPS for more information.


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## How long does it take to obtain insurance coverage?

The time taken to obtain coverage can vary by insurance policy. Insurance is just one part of the process. BPPS will also help you locate a site of care, arrange your infusion appointments, and answer questions you have along the way.

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## **Do you know what my co-pay would be if I start NAGLAZYME™ (galsulfase) therapy?**

Once the prior authorization process is complete and your plan has approved coverage for therapy, we can estimate your potential co-payment or coinsurance.



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## **What is a prior authorization?**

Your insurance company may need to approve your treatment plan before your treatment center can be reimbursed. This approval is called a “prior authorization.” Typically, this means that your physician will need to provide your health plan with a letter of medical necessity that explains why your physician wants you to start this treatment.

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## **Does Medicaid cover NAGLAZYME™ (galsulfase)?**


Medicaid plans are required by law to cover medically necessary procedures and therapies. Most Medicaid plans cover NAGLAZYME therapy. BPPS can assist you and your physician through the Medicaid reimbursement process.



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## **Does Medicare cover NAGLAZYME?**

Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans are required by law to cover medically necessary procedures and services. BPPS can assist you and your physician through the Medicare reimbursement process.



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## **What will I do if my insurance does not cover my therapy?**

If your insurance does not cover therapy with NAGLAZYME, BPPS may be able to assist you in appealing that decision. If your insurance company upholds its decision after the appeal process has been exhausted, we may be able to help you identify alternative sources of coverage.

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## Indication

**NAGLAZYME™ (galsulfase) is indicated for patients with mucopolysaccharidosis VI (MPS VI).**

**NAGLAZYME has been shown to improve walking and stair-climbing capacity.**

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## Important Safety Information

The most common adverse events observed in clinical trials in patients treated with NAGLAZYME were headache, fever, arthralgia, vomiting, upper respiratory infections, abdominal pain, diarrhea, ear pain, cough, and otitis media. Severe reactions included angioneurotic edema, hypotension, dyspnea, bronchospasm, respiratory distress, apnea, and urticaria. The most common symptoms of infusion reactions included fever, chills/rigors, headache, rash, and mild to moderate urticaria. Nausea, vomiting, elevated blood pressure, retrosternal pain, abdominal pain, malaise, and joint pain were also reported. No patients discontinued for adverse events and all patients who completed the double-blind portion of the trial continued to receive weekly infusions of NAGLAZYME. Nearly all patients developed antibodies as a result of treatment, but the level of immune response did not correlate with the severity of adverse events. Because antihistamine use may increase the risk of apneic episodes, evaluation of airway patency should be considered prior to the initiation of treatment. Consideration to delay infusion of NAGLAZYME should be given when treating patients who present with an acute febrile or respiratory illness.
